<p><b>WEEK 1: COLOR</b> <b>June 13 – 17</b></p> <p>Color is the element of art that may be described in terms of hue, lightness, and saturation. Students will be encouraged to explore the relationships between colors through various painting mediums.</p>	<p><b>Paint</b> <b>4:00 - 5:30 pm</b> <b>Instructor: TBD</b></p> <p>Students will be working with various types of paint to explore the basics of color.</p> <p><b>CLASS TUITION: \$70</b></p>	<p><b>Paint</b> <b>10:00 - 11:30 am</b> <b>Instructor: TBD</b></p> <p>Students will be introduced to color theory and create a series of paintings based on the element of color.</p> <p><b>CLASS TUITION: \$70</b></p>	<p><b>Paint</b> <b>12:30 - 3:00 pm</b> <b>Instructor: TBD</b></p> <p>Students will continue to explore more advanced color theory while creating paintings.</p> <p><b>CLASS TUITION: \$80</b></p>
<p><b>WEEK 2: SHAPE</b> <b>June 20-24</b></p> <p>Shapes can be geometric, like squares and circles; or organic, like free-form or natural shapes. Shapes can be used to organize compositions in visual art. Students will create works of art through combining various shapes using multiple mediums.</p>	<p><b>Collage</b> <b>4:00 - 5:30 pm</b> <b>Instructor: TBD</b></p> <p>A collage is a combination of multiple objects and materials. Students will be introduced to shapes through collage.</p> <p><b>CLASS TUITION: \$70</b></p>	<p><b>Collage</b> <b>10:00 - 11:30 am</b> <b>Instructor: TBD</b></p> <p>Students will be working on various 2D and 3D collages using mixed media to explore shape.</p> <p><b>CLASS TUITION: \$70</b></p>	<p><b>Collage</b> <b>12:30 - 3:00 pm</b> <b>Instructor: TBD</b></p> <p>Students will be creating complex compositions to explore the relations of various shapes to each other.</p> <p><b>CLASS TUITION: \$80</b></p>
<p><b>WEEK 3: TEXTURE</b> <b>June 27 – July 1</b></p> <p>Texture is the surface quality that can be seen and felt. Textures can be rough or smooth, soft, or hard. Textures do not always feel the way they look, and many artists use this element when creating work. Students will learn about the visual and physical elements of texture through sculpture and other mediums.</p>	<p><b>Sculpture/Stamp Art</b> <b>4:00 - 5:30 pm</b> <b>Instructor: TBD</b></p> <p>Students will be creating sculptures using mixed media. They will be using stamps to explore the element of Texture.</p> <p><b>CLASS TUITION: \$70</b></p>	<p><b>Sculpture</b> <b>10:00 - 11:30 am</b> <b>Instructor: TBD</b></p> <p>Students will explore texture through mixed media 3D compositions.</p> <p><b>CLASS TUITION: \$70</b></p>	<p><b>Sculpture</b> <b>12:30 - 3:00 pm</b> <b>Instructor: TBD</b></p> <p>Students will explore complex uses of texture in 3D compositions.</p> <p><b>CLASS TUITION: \$80</b></p>
<p><b>WEEK 4: VALUE</b> <b>July 11 - 15</b></p> <p>Value refers to the expression of light and shadow in artworks. Students will be shown various techniques to show value in creating art.</p>	<p><b>Drawing</b> <b>4:00 - 5:30 pm</b> <b>Instructor: TBD</b></p> <p>Students will explore light and shadow through drawing using various media.</p> <p><b>CLASS TUITION: \$70</b></p>	<p><b>Drawing</b> <b>10:00 - 11:30 am</b> <b>Instructor: TBD</b></p> <p>Students will explore value drawing by creating multiple pieces.</p> <p><b>CLASS TUITION: \$70</b></p>	<p><b>Drawing</b> <b>12:30 - 3:00 pm</b> <b>Instructor: TBD</b></p> <p>Students will develop an in depth understanding of value drawing through multiple pieces.</p> <p><b>CLASS TUITION: \$80</b></p>
<p><b>WEEK 5: LINE</b> <b>July 18 - 22</b></p> <p>Line is a mark with greater length than width. Lines can be horizontal, vertical, or diagonal; straight or curved; thick or thin. Line can be used to express many concepts in art. Students will be introduced to a variety of line art styles and exercises to create artworks.</p>	<p><b>Drawing</b> <b>4:00 - 5:30 pm</b> <b>Instructor: TBD</b></p> <p>Drawing techniques will be explored to teach the element of line.</p> <p><b>CLASS TUITION: \$70</b></p>	<p><b>Drawing/Printmaking</b> <b>10:00 - 11:30 am</b> <b>Instructor: TBD</b></p> <p>Drawing and printmaking techniques will be taught to explore the element of line.</p> <p><b>CLASS TUITION: \$70</b></p>	<p><b>Drawing/Printmaking</b> <b>12:30 - 3:00 pm</b> <b>Instructor: TBD</b></p> <p>Advanced drawing and printmaking techniques will be explored so students can build confidence in line techniques.</p> <p><b>CLASS TUITION: \$80</b></p>
<p><b>WEEK 6: FORM/SPACE</b> <b>July 25 - 29</b></p> <p>Forms are three-dimensional shapes expressing length, width, and depth. Space refers to the area around forms and other elements of art. Students will get the chance to explore the relationship between sculptural forms and the space that they interact with.</p>	<p><b>Sculpture</b> <b>4:00 - 5:30 pm</b> <b>Instructor: TBD</b></p> <p>Students will create various sculptures in both group and individual settings.</p> <p><b>CLASS TUITION: \$70</b></p>	<p><b>Sculpture</b> <b>10:00 - 11:30 am</b> <b>Instructor: TBD</b></p> <p>Students will explore form and space by making a large sculpture piece.</p> <p><b>CLASS TUITION: \$70</b></p>	<p><b>3D</b> <b>12:30 - 3:00 pm</b> <b>Instructor: TBD</b></p> <p>Students will explore the relation of form and space through 3D work. Students will create a large group project for the Children's Exhibition.</p> <p><b>CLASS TUITION: \$80</b></p>
