ENROLLMENT & REFUNDS

To enroll your child, fill out the enrollment form and return to Arts Visalia. **Students are recommended to be signed up in classes according to their age group.** Class sizes are limited with enrollment on a first-come first-served basis. To guarantee a place in a class, **tuition must be paid at the time of enrollment, please.** Only enrolled students in their respective class are welcome in the class.

CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

Tuition is non-refundable unless cancelled by the parent at least one week prior to the start of class. In the event a class is cancelled by Arts Visalia, a full refund will be given.

CLASS INFORMATION:

DROP OFF/PICK UP

Please drop off your children **no earlier than 10 minutes before class and pick up no later than 10 minutes after class.** Please inform the instructor if you are having someone else pick up your child. **There is a sign-in sign-out sheet for guardians/authorized pick ups.**

WHAT TO WEAR/BRING

Please send your child to class in clothing they aren't afraid to get dirty. Creating art can get a little messy. Please come prepared to get creative, no toys or tablets. Phones must be placed in cubbies during class time.

PHOTOGRAPHY

Photographs will be taken during class. These photos may be used for our website and/or other promotional material.

STUDENT ARTWORK

Artwork will be displayed in the Young Imaginations Gallery during the month following the enrolled class. Artwork must be taken home at the end of each month's exhibition. We are unable to store artwork that is left behind. For example, if your child is enrolled in February's class their artwork will be displayed for the month of March and will be available for pickup on the last Friday of the month.

Art for Ages 5 - 7

Classes are offered for ages 5-7 years. They provide a fun, hands-on introduction to the joy of art. Young art students are provided with a wide range of materials and are encouraged to interact with different art mediums in a spatially rich environment.
